You may make the number of photocopies necessary for all interested teachers and students. **A WINNER FROM EACH GRADE LEVEL WILL BE SELECTED AND WILL RECEIVE A \$25.00 GIFT CERTIFICATE.** Winning posters will be displayed at the Genesee County Bar Association's Annual Law Day Luncheon, on our web site at www.gcbalaw.org, and in the March/April edition of our bimonthly magazine *Bar Beat*. Due to ongoing renovations at the Flint Public Library we will not be able to have our posters on display this year. We will create a slide show of posters to be placed on our website. Posters will not be returned. Additionally, EVERY student who submits an entry will receive a certificate of participation **(please submit a TYPED class list with the completed posters).**

THEME: Your Vote • Your Voice • Our Democracy: The 19th Amendment at 100

The purpose of Law Day is education on the United States Constitution. The GCBA is asking for the students' interpretations of the above theme through their art.

ELIGIBILITY: Coloring Contest for 2nd and 3rd grades (original artwork is also an option)
Original Poster Design Contest for 4th and 5th grades

REQUIREMENTS: Coloring poster for 2nd and 3rd grade students is enclosed. For 4th and 5th grade student entries must be on an 8 ½ x 11 inch sheet of paper or 8 ½ x 11 inch poster board. The words **Law Day 2020 - Your Vote • Your Voice • Our Democracy : The 19th Amendment at 100** must be included in the design. Media and color used in the design is left to the discretion of the student.

Simple designs and bright colors are suggested. Judging is based on the student's ability to make a statement about the theme.

Please fill out the enclosed **entry form** and attach to the back of **each** entry. Posters **will not** be returned. Additional copies of the entry form can be found at www.gcbalaw.org.

Additionally, EVERY student who submits an entry will receive a certificate of participation.

Please submit a TYPED class list with the completed posters.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING: Originality, expression of theme, visual appeal, ability to follow above-listed requirements.
