Based on the emergency declaration of Governor Whitmer and communications with the Michigan Supreme Court, I am directing the following proceedings are adjourned until after May 1, 2020 effective immediately:

- a. Any scheduled jury trials
- b. Any scheduled misdemeanor pretrials with the exception of defendants in custody.
- c. Non-jury general civil trials and pretrials
- d. Small Claims
- e. Show Cause hearings
- f. Probationers' reporting requirements are suspended until after May 1, 2020.
- g. All other scheduled matters are and will continue to be under review including the expanded use of video proceedings.

The health and safety of court staff and members of the public are of the utmost concern. We will continue to work with the Michigan Supreme Court and the Genesee County Commissioners to ensure that we are doing all that we can to combat this health emergency situation.
