Other submissions will be displayed at the Flint Public Library during the month of May. Posters will not be returned. **SPONSOR:** Genesee County Bar Association

**THEME:** Realizing the Dream: Equality for All  
The purpose of Law Day is education. The GCBA is asking for the student's interpretations of the above theme through their art.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Coloring Contest for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grades (original artwork is also an option)  
Original Poster Design Contest for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades

**REQUIREMENTS:** Coloring poster for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students is enclosed. For 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade student entries must be on an 8 ½ x 11 inch sheet of paper or 8 ½ x 11 inch poster board. The words **Law Day 2013 - Realizing the Dream: Equality for All** must be included in the design. Media and color used in the design is left to the discretion of the student.

Simple designs and bright colors are suggested. Judging is based on the student's ability to make a statement about the theme.
