Neithercut Legal Education Fund

The Neithercut Fund of the Genesee County Bar Foundation is committed to the continuing legal education of our members who are either sole practitioners or members of law firms. This year the Foundation has increased the scholarship benefits for our members. The Board of the Foundation policy is to encourage seminar participation. Beginning December 1, 2020 and until further notice, the Neithercut Fund of the Genesee County Bar Foundation will now pay for 60% of the cost of tuition per attorney per year, not to exceed \$500 per Attorney per year, to any

- Institute of Continuing Legal Education (ICLE) Seminar of the State Bar of Michigan (SBM);
- American Bankruptcy Institute;
- Federal Bar Association Bankruptcy Section; and
- Criminal Defense Attorneys of Michigan.

This is not a need-based scholarship but a benefit available to every member whether they pay for their CLE or it is paid by their firm or partnership.

The Michigan Supreme Court has announced the appointment of Judge Christopher R. Odette as the Chief Judge of the 67th District Court. The 67th District Court encompasses all of Genesee County and Includes 10 Judges.



Judge Odette has served as a Judge for 27 years and has served as either Chief Judge or Presiding Judge for over 12 years. He currently serves In the Grand Blanc Court. He is a graduate of Michigan State University and MSU Law School, Detroit College of Law.



Judge William Crawford, II will serve as Chief Judge Pro-Tem. Judge Crawford graduated from Flint Central High School. He then went to the Ohio State University where he obtained an undergraduate Bachelor of Arts degree and graduated from the Ohio State College of Law.

Upon passing the Michigan Bar, Judge Crawford helped to open the very first UAW Legal Service Plan Office in the Flint area and worked in private practice before going to work at the Flint City Attorney's Office where he eventually served as the Chief Legal Officer.

Judge Jennifer Manley and Judge David Guinn will serve as Presiding Judges of the Court.



Judge Jennifer Manley currently serves in the Davison Court. She graduated from Goodrich High School, Michigan State University, William Tyndale College and WMU Thomas M Cooley Law School. She served as a trial lawyer for over a decade in the Genesee County Prosecutors' Office. She later entered private practice at the Manley Firm.

Judge Manley was elected to serve as a Genesee County District Judge in 2014 and has also served as Chief Judge Pro-Tem and represented the Court in numerous functions.



Judge David Guinn was appointed to the 67th District Court bench by Governor Snyder in May 2017. He was an Assistant Prosecuting Attorney (APA) for 19 years before being appointed to the bench. As an APA, he was assigned to the Child Support Division, District Court Division, Family Court Division, Drug & Asset Forfeiture Division, Circuit Court Trial Division, and the Auto Theft Division.

After graduating from GVSU, Judge David Guinn moved to Ada, Ohio to attend law school at Ohio Northern University (ONU).


