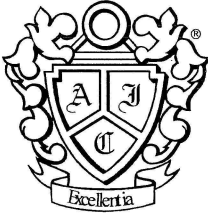

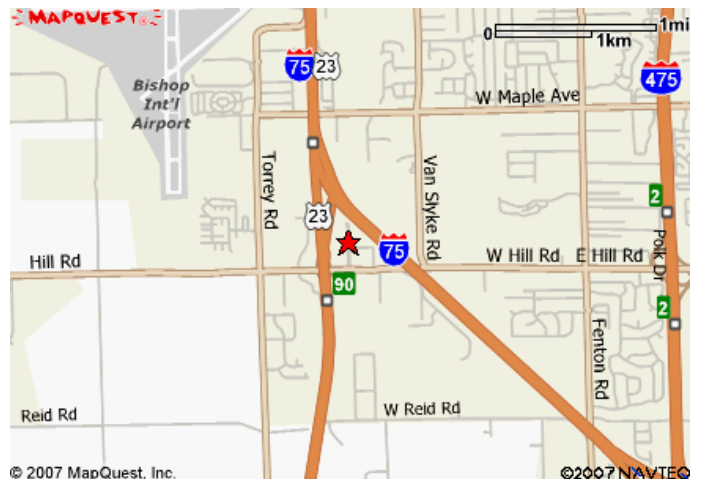

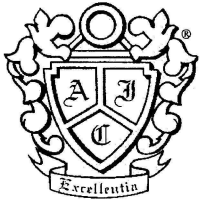

68TH DISTRICT COURT COLLECTION IMPROVEMENT PLAN

The State of Michigan passed a law that requires fines, costs and other financial obligations imposed by the court to be paid at the time of assessment.

In response to the new court rule, the 68th District Court has developed a plan for the implementation of a Collections Program. The program has 2 major benefits. First, it encourages personal responsibility and second, it increases revenue. Improving collections benefits both the City of Flint and the State of Michigan. Most of the funds collected are retained locally and used to fund local programs (e.g. courthouse security, court technology, and records management) and to increase local general revenue. A portion of what is collected is remitted to the State to fund numerous worthwhile programs (e.g. compensation to victims of crime, criminal justice planning, and indigent defense). A large amount of that money from the State is returned to Genesee County and the City of Flint.

The 68th District Court now has a centralized Collections Department that is responsible for the collection of fines/fees. It has been a challenge, but as time goes by, things seem to be falling into place. The staff currently consists of a Collections Supervisor, Melissa Gifford, and another collector/clerk. Eventually, the Collection Department hopes to hire enough staff to collect on old cases.

Our goal and mission is to hold everyone accountable that owes the 68th District Court, and in turn, the City of Flint, money for fines and fees.

68TH DISTRICT COURT Announces

AMNESTY PROGRAM: No 20% late fees for traffic and parking tickets

Got outstanding bench warrants with unpaid fines and costs, traffic and parking tickets with unpaid fines and costs?

The 68TH DISTRICT COURT has a deal for you: Pay in person or by mail February 15, 2008 through March 31, 2008 and avoid paying the 20% late fees.

Those with unpaid traffic and parking tickets can come into the court to pay their fines and costs. Payments by mail must have the ticket/case/citation number on the check or money order, indicate for amnesty program, and must be postmarked no later than March 31, 2008 to get a break on the 20% late fees. Those people currently in bench warrant status are included in the amnesty program and will have no threat of arrest for these violations.

The amnesty program, however, is only a break on local late fees. The court cannot excuse the state's penalties and fines, for example, for those who have suspended driver's licenses.

Jerome F. O'Rourke Advocacy Award Protocol



The Jerome F. O'Rourke Advocacy Award will be considered annually for recognition of a member of the Genesee County Bar Association who demonstrates the highest level of professional excellence in advocacy, and who exemplifies the other principles of the American Inns of Court: Professionalism, Ethics and Civility. The recipient will be selected by the Executive Committee of the Centennial Chapter of the American Inns of Court using the following protocol.

Nomination

The Executive Committee will solicit nominations from the membership of the Genesee County Bar Association at GCBA membership meetings, when appropriate, and using an insert in the GCBA flier. The Inns will provide the flier insert.

Selection

The Executive Committee will consider nominations every year, but the Committee might not select an award recipient every year. The factors considered by the Committee will include:

The use of novel and effective legal arguments or techniques;

The willingness to represent unpopular clients or causes;

The willingness to recognize and promote the interests of the client, including the promotion of settlement or alternative dispute resolution where appropriate;

The promotion of respect for the legal profession and the judicial system by cooperation with all participants in the legal system, including court personnel, opposing counsel, opposing clients, witnesses, and the public; and

Recognition of his/her stewardship in the judicial system by avoidance of conduct that disparages the Courts and its officials and other counsel.

Award

A recipient of the award will be recognized by the President of the Inns at the GCBA annual meeting. The Inns will provide a suitable plaque at its expense.

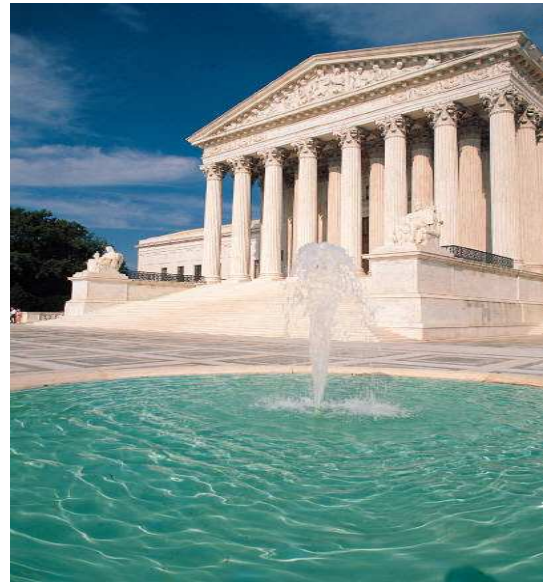

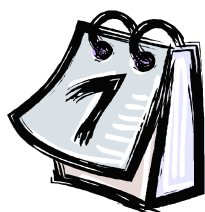

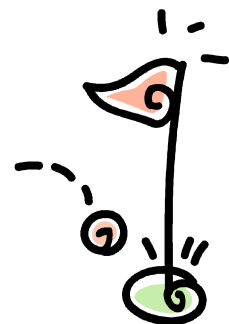
