Neithercut Legal Education Fund

The Neithercut Fund of the Genesee County Bar Foundation is committed to the continuing legal education of our members who are either sole practitioners or members of law firms. 

SBM's 44th Legal Milestone: Percy J. Langster, The nation's first Elected Black prosecuting attorney

Nancy Vogl, featured by the SBM in August 2023, unearthed a groundbreaking discovery while researching Idlewild, Michigan, for a screenplay. Ten minutes before the library closed, she found a misfiled folder containing a yellowed newspaper clipping from the Kalamazoo Gazette. This revealed the story of Percy J. Langster, the first African American elected prosecuting attorney in the United States. Vogl's research brought Langster's previously unknown tale to the forefront, capturing the attention of the American Bar Association and the State Bar of Michigan. Her work now aims to tell the untold and historic story of Percy J. Langster.

As a prolific writer, she has coauthored "Chicken Soup for the Single Parent's Soul" and penned award-winning children's books like "Am I a Color Too?" Her lyrical talents have garnered international recognition, with her song "Here I Am" winning the Grand Prize in Australia and "If Only For Today" earning high honors in Ireland for the International Song of Peace.

Member Rate

The conference room available <u>free</u> of charge to all GCBA members. Approval necessary for room rental prior to 9:00 a.m. or after 5:00 p.m., with at least two weeks prior notification.
