Through community efforts and the assistance of the Elder Abuse Prevention Program, Department of Social Services and other senior advocates and agencies, we will continue to strive to meet the needs of older persons who are abused, neglected, and/or exploited. We are all committed to provide services for older persons who suffer from abuse and neglect, we provide advocacy services for older persons in need, and provide awareness and training opportunities for professionals and community groups to increase education levels on the prevention of elder abuse. Currently, Sheriff Robert Pickell is advocating for appropriate state wide legislative action to protect older persons.

Program

The Elder Abuse Prevention Program of the Genesee County Sheriff's Elder Abuse Prevention Program in collaboration with the Elder Abuse Task Force has developed a committee dedicated to protecting the safety, security and well-being of Genesee County's most vulnerable citizens. The Elder Abuse Prevention Program was established in 2007 through the funds of a 1/10th of 1% Senior Millage and support from the Genesee County Commissioners.

Paul Greenwood is a Deputy District Attorney who also serves as the Deputy District Attorney of the San Diego District Attorney's Office Elder Abuse Prosecution Unit. He has been involved in over 400 felony cases of elder and adult abuse. He also took part in the drafting of Elder Abuse Legislation in California. In 1999, Mr. Greenwood was among those named "Attorneys of the Year" by *California Lawyer* magazine.

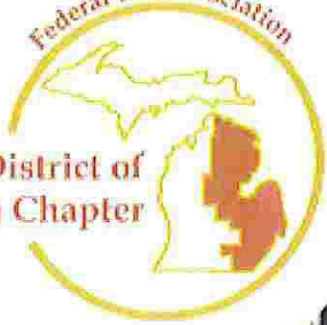

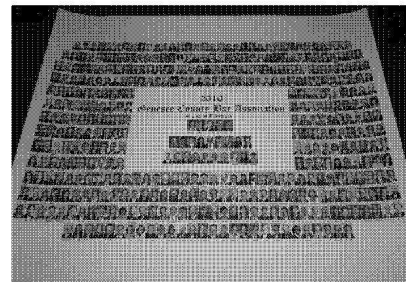

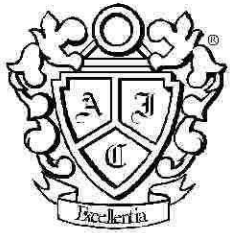
