

Participants will receive a detailed mediation manual and a jump-drive containing reproducible mediation forms.

8-Hour Domestic Violence Screening Training: This 8-Hour State Court Administrative Office (SCAO) approved training is designed to teach mediators how to screen for domestic violence to determine if mediation is appropriate. The training is a required supplemental training to the 40-Hour Domestic Relations Mediator Training and will also satisfy SCAO 8-Hour advanced mediation training requirements for General Civil Mediators and Domestic Relations Mediators who previously took the 4-hour Domestic Violence Training.

Online 8-Hour Advanced Mediation Training: Both novice and experienced mediators recognize that every case brings new challenges. Every dispute is unique and should cause the mediator to stretch his/her mind and dig deep into his/her tool box of skills.
