This year a criminal case has been chosen, People v Avery Michaelson. Defendant Avery Michaelson is charged with Count I, Carrying a Concealed Weapon; Count II, Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Deliver; Count III, Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance (a lesser included offense); Count IV, Unlawful Use of a Controlled Substance (lesser included offense); and Count V, Possession of Firearm at Time of Commission or Attempted Commission of Felony (Felony Firearm).

The day will begin on Friday, April 26, 2013, at 9:30 a.m. at the Masonic Temple, 755 S. Saginaw Street, downtown Flint, with jury orientation for all participants. This class is not case-specific and will be patterned after the very successful 2012 Law Day juror orientation.

Following orientation, the Law Day Lunch will begin at 11:30 a.m. at the Masonic Temple, all participants are invited. We will also take time to recognize all participating schools and their teacher advisors. Part of this recognition will include a PowerPoint presentation of your students preparing for the Mock Trial, which will be shown continually at the beginning of the lunch.
